Captain Terebetsky is also requesting that if there is a three man shift, can a career firefighter attend with an engine.

Captain Douglas reported that there will be a retirement dinner in October, which Vinny Pereira will be a part of. Captain Douglas inquired if there is any interest in the ad book or buying tickets, which can be purchased through Captain Terebetsky.

Captain Douglas reported that Engine 2-1 had minor damage on the back bumper from the Buckeye fire and stated that it should be replaced or repaired since it could be hazard.

Captain Douglas reported that he reached out to Comcast Business since there were issues with the internet and we are due for an upgrade (free of charge) since it hasn't been upgraded since 2011.

Captain Douglas reported that our funding for the American Rescue Firefighter Grant for \$50,000 is official and we can start using the funds. Captain Douglas reported that the funds had been earmarked for new gear and PPE and he will discuss with Operations Manager Small.

Captain Douglas reported that they secured the grant for the fire boat and had a preliminary meeting with Metal Craft. Captain Douglas stated that he and Operations Manager Small will talk cost match with the town and the time frame.
